# NEVADA POPULATIONS OF POLITES SABULETI. II. REPLACEMENT NAME FOR POLITES SABULETI PALLIDA

Several unfortunate errors appeared in a recent paper (Austin, 1987), and these require correction. The name *Polites sabuleti pallida (op. cit.*:9) is a homonym of *Pamphila pallida* Skinner (1911). I thus propose the following as a replacement name:

#### Polites sabuleti basinensis, nom. nov.

The description, types, type locality and diagnosis remain as in Austin (op. cit.:9-10). The name reflects the central Great Basin distribution of the phenotype.

In addition all the figure legends are placed with the incorrect figures. These should be corrected as follows:
